## ESTIMATED LODGING BUDGET:----

Meal Options: The Visitor Housing has a full kitchen & refrigerator where you can cook & prep all of your meals. There is a Costco & Markets where you can purchase food in Mexico. We also offer options to have meals catered for your team by local cooks. This must be planned I week in advance \* see menus/ price is per person (All meals are family style, everyone eats the same meal. Once the order is placed, we cannot cancel for any reason.) See attached menus for options or ask us about other possible options if you want something else. You can also eat out at local tacos stands & restaurants, there are many great options!

## ESTIMATED MEAL BUDGET:----

Transportation: We have a large van for teams of 10 or less who would rather have personal transportation rather than driving your own vehicles or rental cars. We will pick your team up at the San Diego Airport & drive you during your stay. Upon return you will walk across the border with your luggage & be picked up in San Diego.

5 days or less: \$50 per person 6-10 days: \$75 per person

\*If driving personal vehicles or renting vehicles you will need to purchase Mexico Insurance before crossing the border into Mexico. We also have toll roads here, so it is a great idea to have a Ziplock bag with small bills (tolls are around 45 pesos/2.50 USD, they vary)

Please let us know of any other details or expectations you have for your trip:

- \$250 deposit is required to hold your dates for booking. This will be put towards your total balance & can be transferred to another date in case of emergency
- As your trip near we will work together to create a daily itinerary for your team.
- We will send you a packing list & additional information for you to share with your team as your arrival date nears.
- We have a list of other dorms, hotels, Airbnb & RV sites if you would like more lodging options
